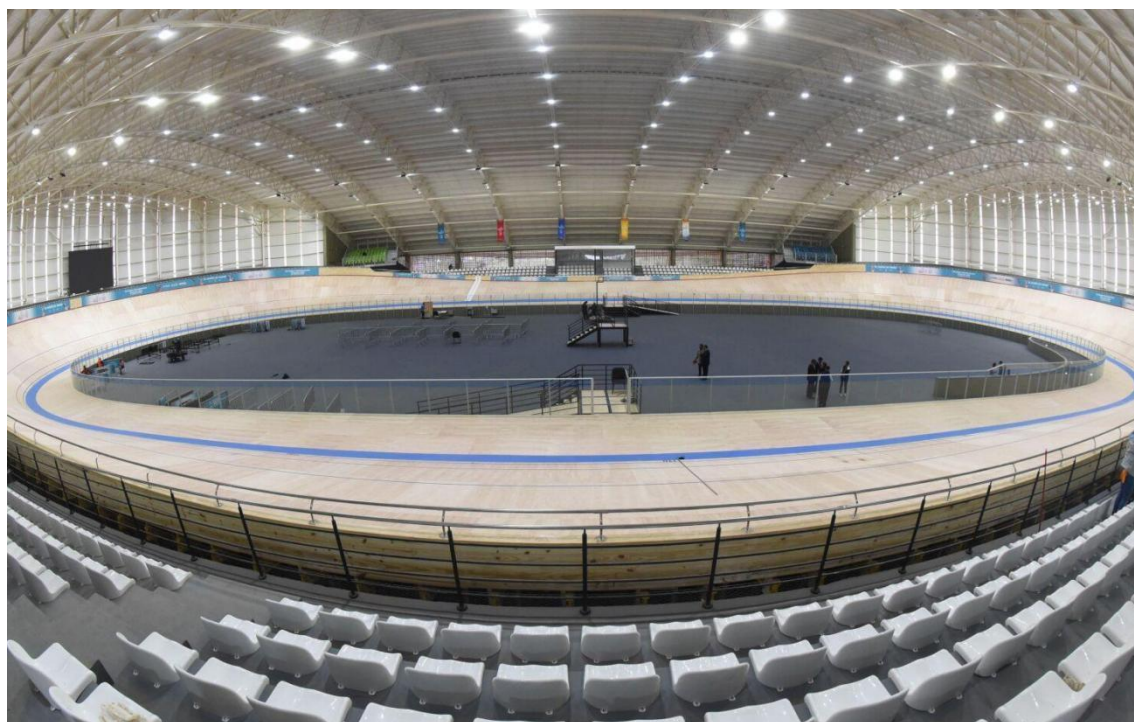


## 2. PARAGUAY: THE HEART OF SOUTH AMERICA

Strategically located at the geographic center of the subcontinent, Paraguay is much more than just a dot on the map; it is the hub that connects the routes of South American sports.



At the epicenter of this “heart” stands our velodrome. A 250-meter, covered wooden track, designed to let speed flow without interference. It is here that the continent’s adrenaline will be pumping hard during these two days of competition.



### 3. GENERAL INFORMATION

a. Dates: May 28 and 29, 2026

b. Location: National Track Cycling Center, Paraguayan Olympic Committee, Luque, Paraguay

c. Eligibility: The event is open to all cyclists with a valid UCI license for 2026, duly authorized by their national federation. Riders may participate representing their team, club, or national team.

d. Technical Meeting

May 27 at 6:00 PM at the National Track Cycling Center, Luque, Paraguay.

e. Registration:

Registration will be conducted using the form provided by the organization and through the respective National Federations by sending an email to [secretaria@fpc.org.py](mailto:secretaria@fpc.org.py), due date May 21.

Registration fees are US\$50.00 (fifty U.S. dollars) per foreign competitor and US\$40.00 (forty U.S. dollars) for domestic competitors.

Foreign cyclists must pay the amount on May 27th during the delivery of race numbers, confirmation and verification.

National cyclists may also pay on the same day or via bank transfer.

5. Omnium (Men's and Women's Elite)
6. Elimination (Men's Elite, Women's Elite, Men's Junior, and Women's Junior)



## 5. UCI TRACK RANKING POINTS

The Paraguay Track America Cup is a Class C2 event on the UCI calendar, counting toward the international ranking. Points will be awarded in accordance with the official UCI regulations for events in this category.

This requires at least 3 nations per event. 12 cyclists for group events and 8 teams for Madison pairs for Class 2 competitions.

## 6. CATEGORIES AND REQUIREMENTS

To compete in a Class 2 event, you must have at least one additional category besides Elite (W/M). This can be Junior (M/W) or Paracycling – minimum one category.

All cyclists must hold a valid UCI license for the year 2026, issued by their respective National Federations.

All foreign cyclists must present authorization from their respective federation and have the corresponding sports accident insurance.

Selected athletes must report to the testing station immediately after their race, accompanied by a designated official.

The penalties set forth in the UCI Penalty Scale (Article 12.4.001) shall apply.

## 13. ORGANIZING COMMITTEE AND PANEL OF COMMISSAIRES



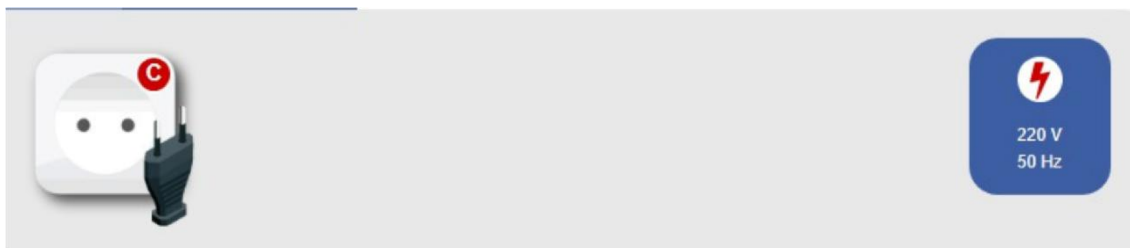
The Paraguayan Cycling Federation is responsible for organizing the event. Technical supervision and officiating shall be the responsibility of international commissaires designated by the UCI, with the support of national commissaires.

#### **14. APPLICABLE REGULATIONS**

The competition will fully comply with the UCI Regulations – Part 3: Track Races, in addition to the provisions contained in this Technical Guide. Any unforeseen cases will be resolved by the Panel of Commissaires.

#### **15. ELECTRICITY.**

The plug type in Paraguay is Type C, the voltage is 220 Vac and the frequency is 50 Hz.



#### **16. LOCAL CURRENCY:**

The legal tender in Paraguay is the Guaraní. The exchange rate against the US Dollar is 1 USD = 6,500 Gs. (fluctuating)
